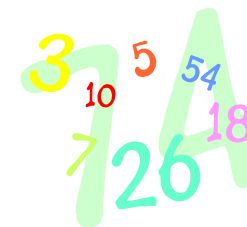

We will be thinking about changes and preparing for them. We will prepare our service for the end of the year, celebrating all we have achieved and the Christian Values that we have developed.



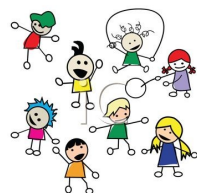
As readers, we will find out about some famous artists. We will then answer questions about their lives and their art.

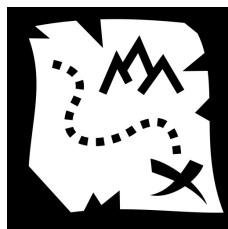
We will be preparing for sports day! We will also continue to work with our sports coach to improve our skills for outside games.
