As mathematicians, we will develop our understanding of number and the four main functions by applying them to real life problems including money and units of measurement. Including calculating journey times, distances and costs.

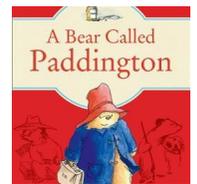
**Computing**
