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Observatory Visit

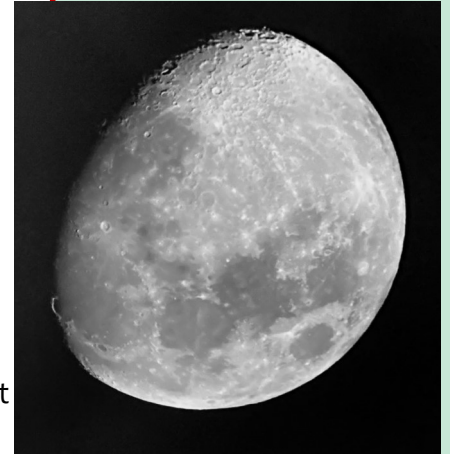
On Thursday evening, some pupils from school visited the Trinity School Observatory.
