Pupils have commented recently on Sports Club being a highlight of their week.

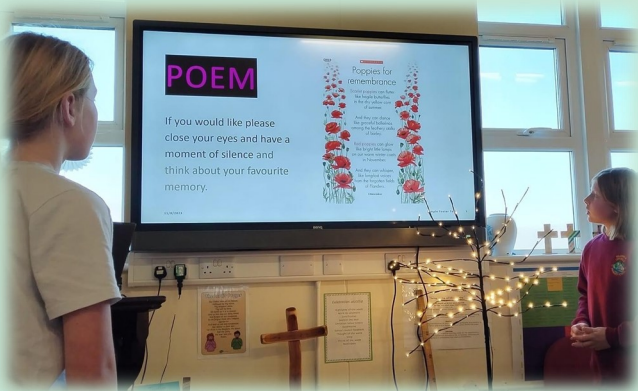
The club is running at lunchtime, which enables more pupils to get involved.
