We will develop our skills in speaking, listening and writing in French. Listen to spoken language and show understanding by responding. Engage in conversations, ask and answer questions. Read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple sentences.

History/Geography/D&T/Art

We will be looking at the development and growth of the railway network across England as an aspect of British history post 1066. We will consider the connections between local, regional and national history and the cultural and economic impact of these developments.

This study will allow us to consider the impact of physical geography on transport networks and the impact on human geography as the network grew and became more accessible. We will be able to improve our locational knowledge of the UK, locating counties and cities and use maps and atlases to learn about the different routes and networks.

In D&T we will be able to research existing design ideas and develop our own through discussion, annotated sketches, prototypes and models, for tracks and bridges

With our PE coach we will be developing our key skills, including catching, throwing, using bats and racquets and moving safely. We will be joining with Bewcastle School to develop our swimming skills.
